PLEASE

- ALL NEW CAMPGROUND ENTRANTS MUST STOP AT THE OFFICE FOR PROPER ENTRY PASS. No campsite set up from 11 p.m. to 10 a.m. the following day without permission from the management.
- 5-3/4 MPH speed limit. Abuse will be cause for eviction.
- Campsites are to be occupied by one family or registered group (4 total people
 unless given permission). One camp unit per site plus one additional tent is
 permitted for dependent juveniles. If second tent is adults or second family, they
 will be charged additional. No minors shall use campsites without parent or
 guardian being present. Campers cannot rent their unit to others. Do not change
 assigned site without permission.
- Your visitors are welcome but are not free. They must first check in at the office to obtain a visitor's pass. If they fail to do so, they will be asked to leave.
- Only 2 cars/trucks per site. All others to be parked in visitors' parking area only.
 Do not park on the grass. Vehicles with boat trailers must be parked in visitors parking area. Exception: With permission of Manager Only.
- No ATV's or golf carts. Motorcycles, including motorized scooters, can be ridden
 to your site only. Special consideration will be given for motorized units for people
 with special needs.
- Our pavilion is available for camper's use for no charge provided it is cleaned up after your event. Additional charge if not cleaned.
- Quiet time 11 p.m. to 9 a.m. (Michigan Time). We take it seriously and so does your neighbor.
- Parents or guardians are personally and legally responsible for their children.
- You are responsible for keeping your campsite clean at all times. No clotheslines.
 Put garbage in bags and PUT IN DUMPSTERS provided. (See map for locations.)
- Help us keep the restrooms clean. No smoking and no dogs allowed, no dishwashing. (Michigan State Laws). A dishwashing station is located on the north end of the white restroom building. Closed during winter.
- Pets must be kept on a leash (not to exceed 6 feet). Do not leave pets unattended
 at the campsite. Clean up after your pet at all times and keep it from barking.
 Visitors cannot bring pets. Boaters who bring pets are required to have them on
 leashes. CLEAN UP AFTER PETS AT ALL TIMES. Aggressive dogs are not
 allowed. Call before bringing yours.

BOAT LAUNCHING AND/OR PARKING POLICY:

- Use of the boat launch only, charter fishing parking, and/or any other day parking is \$5.00 per day, per vehicle. If you are camping at the park, your launch is included in your camping fee.
- Yearly Season passes are available, Oct. 1 thru Sept. 30:
- Berrien Springs Village Resident: \$20 per year.
- Non-resident: \$50 per year.
- Fees for Large groups who want to use the facility, will be left to the discretion
 of the Park Manager. This includes launching and/or any other parking.

Boat & RV Storage Policy

Paved lot: \$2/day, \$50/mo. **Gravel lot:** \$2/day or \$40 mo.

Non-Campers:

A boat cannot be left in the water, and/or tied on the beach, on Park Property while operator is away from the Park. (short time for lunch, gas, etc. is OK.)

A Launching Season Pass is required in addition to the storage fee. A \$5 daily pass can be obtained, each time, for those who do not wish to buy a yearly pass.

Registered Campers:

Boats can be stored on park grounds, but charges may apply. One (1) boat at a time can be tied on the Beach while operator is camping at Park. When a camper leaves for more than 24 hrs., boat must be taken out of the water.

- All fish must be cleaned in the building provided. You must clean up after you are finished. Because of the expense of disposing of the remains, only fish caught off our ramp are to be cleaned here.
- No fireworks!! No firearms, BB gun, bow and arrow, sling shot or weapons of any kind whether legal or not in Michigan.
- Campfires are permitted in designated areas only. Do not move fire rings.
 Extinguish your fire upon retiring or departing Park. Do not put garbage, cans or bottle in fire rings.
- Alcohol is a privilege as long as you limit its use to adults and use common sense. Marijuana use outside of your unit is prohibited.
- Only portable screened rooms and decks. No decks, patios or rooms attached to RV.
- All motor vehicles, boat trailers, travel trailers, 5th wheels, etc. must have a current year license plate. Every guest must maintain adequate insurance on their vehicles, boats, and camping units, and indemnify Shamrock Park and the Village of Berrien Springs for all claims and losses occasioned by the guest, guest's family and visitors.
- The Manager resides here at the Park. However, it is impossible for us to provide 100% security. Shamrock Park shall not be liable for losses due to theft, vandalism, neglect, windstorm, personal injuries or other causes. We reserve the right to evict, without refund, any person(s) vandalizing property, creating excessive noise, using abusive language, abusing alcohol or not abiding by the park policies. Report disturbances 24 hrs. a day to: 269-473-5691. Reports need to be made when happening, not the next day. The Police and Fire Dept. can be reached by dialing 911.
- Camping is an outdoor experience. We do not give refunds for the discomfort of nature. No refunds for unused days.
- SEVERE WEATHER: We urge you to go to the cement block restroom buildings (white building with green shamrocks or in new section tan with green doors).

We believe camping should be a peaceful, relaxing experience with respect for fellow guests and nature. Happy Camping
